Player Code of Conduct

The objective of AGSL is to provide a foundation for the girls of the community, good sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty and respect for authority. We strive for girls to be well-adjusted, energetic and aspire to be good, decent, healthy and trustworthy young ladies.

With that being said, the AGSL Board of Directors has outlined the guidelines and expectations for the season.

- Any disrespect to a coach of AGSL, or the opposing teams, including throwing of equipment or displays of hostility will result in the player being ejected. Upon the second offense, the player will be disqualified from being considered for any All-Star team.
- Any unsportsmanlike conduct in the opinion of the umpire, is grounds for ejection.
- The use of profanity in the form of swearing, obscenities, derogatory or abusive remarks are never appropriate and have no place in AGSL.
- There will be no intimidation of players by other players or parents.
- Smoking is not permitted in or around the dugout or on the field at any time.
- Cell phone usage is not permitted in the dugout or on the field during games.
- AGSL will provide game jerseys for players. No other uniform will be permitted during an official game. Personally supplied, properly size black slider pants or black athletic (not bicycle or yoga shorts). No yoga pants or other athletic style pants are permitted.
- No public displays of affection in or around the dugout, or on the playing field
- Players shall never place the value of winning over the safety and welfare of players.
- Professional respect, before, during and after the Game, should be mutual. There should be no demeaning or threatening dialogue or gestures between Umpire, Coaches or Players.

A team manager or umpire may eject a player per the aforementioned guidelines. Additional penalties up to the discretion of the AGSL Board are not limited and could include suspension for the entire season and from the league.
